The papers corresponding to the requirements will be published in the Collection Proceedings of conference materials.

Maximum two papers per participant are accepted.

IN BRIEF:

The papers will be submitted in English, Romanian or Russian (the title, abstract, key words will also be presented in English).

- The length of the final paper should not exceed 6 pages in A4 size, including tables, figures, bibliography and references.

- Make sure the presenter's name is correct as it will be used in the certificate of attendance.

- The presentation in Power Point will be shared by presenter.
