6. Objectives of the subject/module

Overall objective	This discipline has the task to familiarize and train the students with the legal regulation of relations arising from the practice of entrepreneurial activity; the establishment and registration of a legal person for profit; the reorganization and liquidation of legal persons for profit; the insolvency of legal persons; the importance and drawbacks of practicing entrepreneurial activity, etc.
Specific objectives	- defining all concepts covered by business legislation. - arguing the need to include some or other facts under the entrepreneurial regulatory framework. - demonstrating the soundness of the scientific theories chosen as support to clarify the legal nature of the branch of commercial law. - description of the identifying signs of commercial law principles. - identification of the constitutive elements of all existing organizational-legal forms in the Republic of Moldova. - identification and assessment of the forms of reorganization of legal persons for profit through the prism of practice. - identifying and describing the stages of dissolution and liquidation of legal persons for profit. - description of the insolvency process and identification of all procedures in the insolvency process. - formulating proposals for the compatibility and adaptation of the provisions of the rules in the field of local business with the provisions of European legislation and international conventions ratified by the Republic of Moldova. - contributing to the legal literacy of the population in commercial law, etc.
